## POLICY ON MANAGEMENT OF THE VARIOUS TYPES OFF DEGRADABLE AND NON-BIODEGRADABLE WASTES

J. S. M. College, Alibag is committed to manage wastes in such a systematic way so as to minimize its impact on the environment. This document implies to explore various waste management methods to reduce the burden on our environment.

The important policy objectives are as follows:

- 1. To create awareness for reduction of waste production on campus.
- 2. To follow eco-friendly practices in daily activities and Programmes.
- 4. To ban the use of plastic-bags at campus; instead use the bags made out of cloth or some eco-friendly material.
- 5. Reduce the usage of paper by encouraging techno-centric teaching-learning methods and in administrative office.
- 7. To develop systematic waste management mechanism.
- 8. To encourage the use of paper cups for tea in canteen.

Efforts for Solid Waste Management: Dust bins have been provided for waste collection. The waste on the campus is disposed of in an eco-friendly manner without polluting the environment. Dry waste is collected regularly with the help of the non-teaching staff of the college. There are 3 compost pits with sizes of 10 x10 x8 ft. which generate adequate manure for the gardens on campus. 'Swachha Bharat Abhiyan' -India's biggest cleanliness drive was implemented by our NSS students.

Efforts for Liquid waste management: Liquid chemical wastes generated from the laboratories are neutralized using a proper process. Use of sand-tray for preventing spillage of concentrated acids, use of micro-scale techniques in the organic practical, use of hand-gloves, and safety measure charts are displayed in the laboratories. Chemical fire extinguishers are charged periodically by outside licensed agencies.

Efforts for E-Waste Management: The life of electronic equipment is extended by appropriate upkeep and minor repairs carried out by laboratory experts and reused on the campus itself.
