BEST PRACTICE-2

TITLE: ENVIRONMENT CONSERVATION

GOAL: Our main objectives are

- To make aware the students for rapidly depleting natural resources & make them contribute to prudent and rational use of natural resources.
- To make the surrounding cleaner & greener for the current as well as future generation.
- To increase awareness about environmental issues.
- Active participation in the protection of environment.

Context:

Environmental degradation is the deterioration of the environment through consumption of assets like Air, Water & Soil. The destruction of environment & the eradication of wild life, Air Pollution, Water Pollution, Garbage & Pollution of the natural environment are all challenges for India. Environmental degradation is one of the primary cause of disease, health issues & long term livelihood impact of India.

The need for energy is one of the crucial factors in determining the emission of greenhouse gases & its consequences in phenomenon such as Global warming & climate change.

Air pollution is the first environmental cause of death. Urban air pollution (Mainly by NO₂ & ozone) is a serious problem in many cities & road transportation is major cause of pollution.

Water resources are indispensable for life; the quantity is limited at many regions of the planet.

Waste generated in the offices is not very dangerous but waste generated in chemistry laboratory and chemical industries are hazardous for community.

Practice:

- Air Pollution
- Day by day use of bicycles, e-vehicles, and CNG vehicles increased.
- College celebrated 'No Vehicle Day' on college campus.

- Most of the college students belong to rural area, so they travel by public state transport services to reach college.
- Students participated in various programmes like tree plantation, Swacchata Abhiyan Organized by college as well as by Alibag Municipal Council.
- Encourage external communication through video conference for Meeting, Seminar etc.

Waste Management:

- College promote a system of internal communication between employers, making use of new technologies (Internet, E-Mail, Social Media etc.) reduce the use of papers.
- For college canteen, use of paper cup to serve tea is compulsory.
- Sanitary medical waste incinerate by using sanitary vending machine installed in girls hostel.
- Non-degradable waste collected & handover to Alibag Municipal Council for the further processing.
- Degradable waste collected & converts into compost college has compost pit of size 10" x 10" college used compost for the trees planted on the college campus.
- In chemistry laboratory there are acid waste, base waste as well as organic solvents that can't be drain as it is because its hazardous for society. So acid waste & base waste are essentially neutralized by following proper process & then drained out. Organic solvents are recovered by distillation method & reused.
- 'No use of plastic' posters are displayed at various places on college campus.

To reduce consumption of water

- Students, teaching & non-teaching staff aware of minimum use of water by putting "Save Water" posters at various places on college campus.
- Rain water harvesting
- Immediately solve possible leakages in pipes and in taps Water from building roof is collected and reused.

To reduce consumption of electricity

- Solar street lights are installed.
- Students, teaching & non-teaching staff aware of minimum use of electricity by putting posters “Save Energy” at many places on college campus.
- Replaced traditional tube lights by LED bulbs & tub lights at some places.
- Use air conditioning equipment in the optimum comfort ranges for employees.
- Use air conditioning devices when & where necessary.

Evidence of success:

- In Maharashtra major part of electricity generated in thermal plant, it creates a lot of pollution. College decided to use solar energy as well as to reduce the consumption of electricity by replacing traditional tube lights by LED bulbs & tubes at some places.
- Distilled water required for chemistry practical fulfilled by rain water harvesting.
- Alibag Municipal Council conducted various activities like Tree Plantation, Swachhata Abhiyan etc. College students participated in these activities actively. Our institute received award of recognition from Alibag Municipal Council.

Problems encountered & Resources required

- To replace all traditional tubes by LED bulbs & tubes at a time not possible due to financial limitations. College has decided to replace LED bulbs gradually every year.
- Now a days we are facing E-waste problem. To overcome this problem we handover the E-waste to private agency for processing & recycling.

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
