4. The Practice

A. Electoral Literacy Club

5. Evidence of Success

1. Title of the Practice: Environmental Management

2. Goal:

Air, Water and Soil are the main constituent of the environment. Due to urbanization, industrialization and rapidly growing population, we are facing various physical and mental problems. Our college has decided to organize various activities to reduce Air, Water and Soil pollution, and make a healthy atmosphere. Our main objectives are:-

- To increase awareness about environmental issues.
- To explore possible solution for the environmental issues.
- Active participation in the protection of environment.
- To make aware the students for rapidly depleting natural resources and makethem contribute to prudent and rational use of natural resources.
- To make the surrounding cleaner and greener for the current as well asfuture generation.

3. The Context:

Environmental degradation is the disintegration of the earth or deterioration of the environment through consumption of assets like Air, Water and Soil. The destruction of environment and the eradication of wild life, air pollution, water pollution, garbage and pollution of the natural environment are all challenges for India. Pollution remains major challenge and opportunity for India. Environmental degradation is one of the primary causes of disease, health issues and long term livelihood impact of India.

The need for energy is one of the crucial factors in determining the emission of greenhouse gases and its consequences in phenomena such as Global warming and climate change. Water resources are indispensable for life; their quantity is limited at many regions of the planet. Present serious problems of scarcity and water stress. In the offices, the water computation is mainly produced in the toilets and cleaning of the space. Waste generated inthe offices is not classified as dangerous but waste generated in chemistry laboratory is hazardous for community. Air pollution is the first environmental cause of death. Urban airpollution (mainly by NO₂ and Ozone) is a serious problem in many cities, and road transportation is major cause of pollution.

4. Practice: To reduce consumption of Electricity

- Use of solar energy. Solar panels fitted on the roof provide average 2000kWh power to the grid.
- Use air conditioning devices when and where necessary.
- Use air conditioning equipment in the optimum comfort ranges for employees.
- Replace traditional tube lights by LED bulbs and tube lights at some places. Installed one solar unit
- Students, Teaching and Non-Teaching staff aware of minimum use of electricity by Putting posters “Save Electricity” at many places on college campus as well as putswitches off wherever not necessary of light.

To reduce consumption of Water

- Immediately solve possible leaks and water leaks in taps.
- Rain water harvesting
- Students, teaching and Non-Teaching staff aware of minimum use of water by putting “Save Water” posters at some places.

Waste Management

- Degradable waste collected and converts it into compost. College has compost pit of size 10' x 10'. College used compost for the trees planted on the college campus.
- Non degradable waste collected and handover to Alibag Municipal Council for the further processing.
- In Chemistry laboratory there are acid wastes, base waste as well as organic solvents that can't be drain as it is because it's hazardous for society. So acid waste and base waste get neutralized by following proper process and then drained out. Organic solvents recover by distillation method and reused.
- Sanitary medical waste incinerate by using sanitary vending machine installed in girls hostel.
- College promotes a system of internal communication between employers, making use of new technologies (internet, email, social networking etc.) to reduce use of paper.
- “No use of plastic” posters are displayed at various places on college campus.

Air Pollution

- Most of the college students belong to rural area, so they travel by public state transport services to reach college.
- Students participated actively in various programme like tree plantation, Swacchta Abhiyan organized by Alibag Municipal Council.
- College celebrated “No vehicle Day” on college campus.

5. Evidence of Success

- In Maharashtra major part of electricity generated in thermal plant, it creates a lot of pollution. College decided to use alternate source of energy i.e. solar energy as well as to reduce the consumption of electricity by replacing traditional tube lights by LED bulbs and tubes at some places. This action of college reduces the electricity bill. Use of solar panels reduced around Rs. 20,000 of electricity charges per month.
- Distilled water is a necessary thing for practical especially for the subject of chemistry. Initially college made it available from R.C.F. industry located nearby 8 K.M. from the college. Our college implemented rain water harvesting and fulfilled the need of distilled water.
- Air is a main constituent of environment, but due to industrialization and urbanization the air becomes polluted. Alibag Municipal Council conducted various activities like tree plantation, Swachhata Abhiyan etc. College students participated in these activities actively. We received award of recognition from Alibag Municipal Council.
- Day by day use of bicycles, e-vehicles and CNG vehicles has increased.

6. Problems encountered and resources required

- To replace all the traditional tubes by LED bulbs and tube lights at a time not possible due to financial limitation. To overcome this problem we installed LED bulbs and tubes at some places. College has decided to replace LED bulbs gradually every year.
- Now days we are facing non-degradable waste and e-waste problem. To overcome this problem we handover the e-waste to private agency for processing and recycling as well as in college canteen plastic tea cups replace by paper cups.

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
