We are happy to put the annual Report of our college for academic year 2021-22. Our college has taken consistent efforts to enhance the quality the quality of organisation in terms of academic, co-curricular, curricular, research, extension and outreach activities.

Following are the outcomes of the efforts taken during the academic year 2021-22

- Conducted Students satisfaction Survey for the academic year.
